

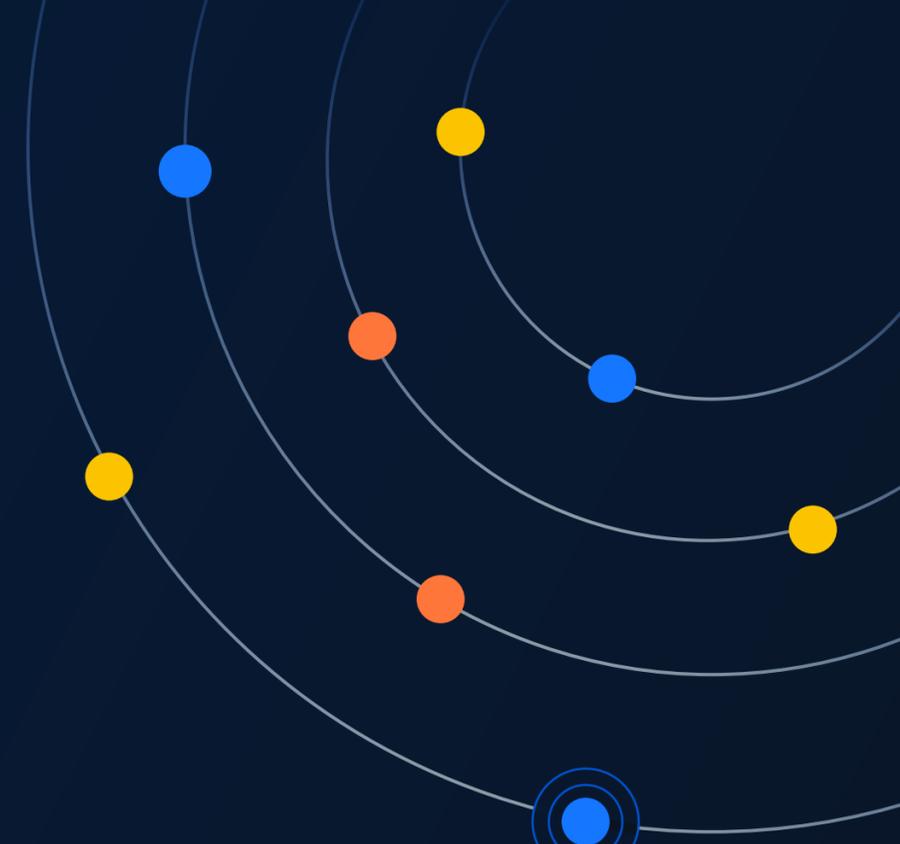


Navigating the Compliance Software Market: **How to Find Your Perfect Match**

Finding the right compliance management software can be overwhelming, to say the least.

There are too many similar-looking security compliance products that promise the same experience, making it difficult for you to pick the right solution.

Questions to ask before choosing a Security Compliance Automation Platform

01. Effort and Time

Many compliance automation solutions promise a plug-and-play experience but, in reality, require many, many hours to set up and configure, draining the team's bandwidth and eating into CTO hours. It's important to understand upfront the true time and investment that will be needed from the leadership team and other key stakeholders during the compliance process.

02. Support & Guidance

Compliance can be challenging, especially for businesses that are just starting on their compliance journey. While most compliance platforms offer documentation and tutorials to guide you along the way – sometimes that’s just not enough. You will find yourself in complex situations that go beyond the resources offered by the platform and require specialized compliance experts.

03. Product Features to make implementation seamless

Compliance is no walk in the park, different compliance frameworks have varying regulations.

It's always a good idea to look for platforms that offer unique features such as custom workflows, productized controls as opposed to document-based controls, in-built MDM software, etc. to make the journey more manageable.

04. Scaleable? Platform Grow with your business needs?

As you move upmarket, you will require compliance certifications for multiple frameworks such as CCPA, Fedramp, PCI DSS, HIPAA, and so on. To make your life easier, it's a good idea to choose a compliance automation platform that supports several frameworks and comes with pre-loaded control mapping. With pre-loaded control mapping, you can build on your existing compliance work to become compliant with new frameworks more easily without starting from scratch.

05. Cost of Ownership: Platform and Additional tools

Compliance can be costly. Certain GRC tools and compliance platforms require you to purchase additional tools such as MDM software, Incident tracking software, vulnerability scanner, security training implementation fee, etc., adding up to your costs. To reduce the burden on your budget, consider a tool with in-built capabilities or strong integrations, allowing for a comprehensive security compliance journey without needing separate purchases.

06. Audits Related

What are some Red flags to watch out for in a Security Compliance Automation Platform?

Tools promising 100% automation

Beware of platforms that set inaccurate and unrealistic automation expectations but don't deliver on their promise. Security compliance cannot be fully automated as of today and requires certain degree of manual intervention.



Slow customer support

Choose a company that provides support in your timezone and is available across channels such as email, live chat, social media or phone.



Shrink-wrapped product

Watch out for products that have a set of pre-defined rules and regulations and may not be able to adapt to new regulatory changes or industry standards.



One-size-fits-all

Most software compliance platforms blanket apply the same checks across all entities, resulting in compliance failures. Choose a platform that sweeps through your entities and checks them depending on the context, ensuring an intelligent compliance engine for your business.



Lack of Tiered escalation

Checks don't go from pass to fail in one go. Most software tools warn you about failing checks only after they turn red. Choose a tool that warns you before anything turns red so you have enough time to fix problems before going to audit.



Support for automated and non-automated checks/controls

Most compliance platforms don't allow you to track manual checks on their dashboard. Go for a platform that allows you to monitor all checks – automated and manual- on a single dashboard. Stay on top of your game and ensure complete compliance with confidence



The product hasn't released any new features

The key to finding the right tool is to look for the frequency of updates, as it clearly indicates how much the company is investing in improving its product. Check the company's blog/product announcements to see if the Compliance automation tool you're considering is truly at the forefront of innovation.



Bad customer reviews

Refer to software comparison websites like G2, Capterra, etc to learn more about how businesses are using these platforms. Also, keep an eye out for how the company responds to negative reviews to evaluate how much the brand cares about its customers' concerns and complaints.
